Rules and Regulations

1. This league will not be sanctioned with the USBC.
2. **The League will be 7 weeks long** and each team captain will be required to notify their team of the schedule. Start times will be 5:45 PM and 8:15 PM on Tuesday evenings.
3. **The league fee will be \$160 per team**, payable to Capital Crossroads SID before the start of league play.
4. **Teams** are co-ed and may consist of up to 8 bowlers, but only four may bowl in a game. You may substitute bowlers between games. There must be an equal number of females and males participating in a game.
5. **Handicap** will be figured from the first night of bowling. The handicap shall be based on 80% and shall be figured on the difference between each individual average and 190 scratch for both men and women.
6. **Vacancy or blind scores** will be 93 for both men and women with a handicap of 77 effective the first night of bowling. You may only use a vacancy for two weeks. Once handicaps have been established a blind score will be used. The blind score will be the bowler's average -10 pins plus his handicap.
