

Acceptable Items

Plastic

All plastic bottles #1-7 accepted
Labels do not need to be removed
NOTE: please rinse all containers

Glass

Clear, brown, green, blue
Only glass bottles in which food products are packaged
Labels do not need to be removed
NOTE: please rinse all containers

Paper

Newspaper with Ad slicks, magazines, phone books (seasonal), brown grocery bags, "junk" mail, chip board, Corrugated cardboard, office paper, pizza boxes (trash the liner)

Beverage & Steel Food Cans

Aluminum and bi-metal beverage cans, steel food/tin cans, aluminum foil, empty aerosol cans
Labels do not need to be removed
NOTE: please rinse all containers

Unacceptable Items

Glass

Ceramics, window or drinking glasses, light bulbs

Metals

Paint cans, coat hangers, steel scraps

Aceptic Containers

Gable-top cartons or paperboard containing such items as milk, juice, fabric softener, egg substitute containers, frozen food cartons, frozen juice containers, etc.
